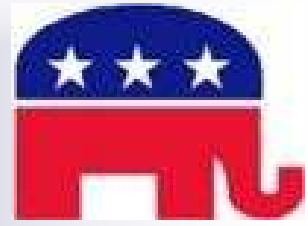

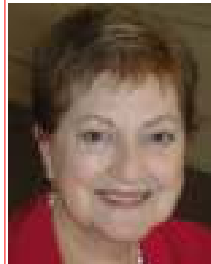

Our own Fred Smith recently went on the flight with his son. Here he is getting a grand sendoff on his flight to Washington D.C. by friends and family.



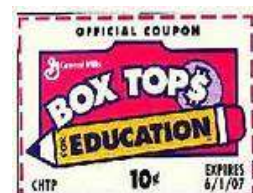
