November Speaker – Randall Jordan, Chair, SLO County Republican Party



Mr. Jordan gave an overview of the 2018 election, with which he expressed disappointment because of the failure of Republican candidates to be elected, despite the Republicans having actual candidates on the statewide ballot, which in California can be considered unusual because of the open primary system. He outlined and stressed that Republicans must start now for 2020 and become involved at all levels, precinct, city, county, and state, especially by registering new Republicans. His goal for that is to have registration tables at every public function – festivals, farmers’ market, etc. Republicans have a large challenge, and volunteers at all levels are needed to achieve these goals.

Mr. Jordan also handed out Certificates of Appreciation to the numerous volunteers who “walked” the neighborhoods handing out door hangers and to the “drivers” who supported the walkers. He said this was a true example of grass-roots participation in government.
