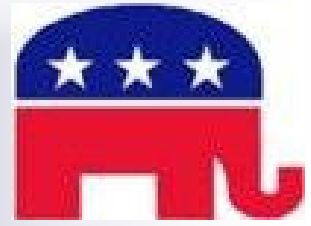

### President Lincoln Club Lieutenant Colonel Alfred J. Fonzi II, U.S. Army (Ret.)

Al Fonzi is a retired Army Lieutenant Colonel with over 36 years of military service, both enlisted and commissioned, upon his retirement in January, 2006. Since his retirement he has been employed as a consultant for SRI International, an affiliate of Stanford University and is a specialist in counterterrorism, disaster management and other issues regarding Homeland Security.

A career intelligence officer, he served multiple combat tours of duty in Vietnam, and various assignments throughout the Cold War, to include duty with Army Special Forces. He served in Europe, Korea, and the Middle East, to include service in Bosnia as the Chief of Counterintelligence and HUMINT for the National Intelligence Cell in Sarajevo. During the 1990's, he served as a counter narcotics intelligence officer while assigned to the DEA and FBI in South Central Los Angeles and along the Mexican border. His last combat tour was in Iraq in 2004 during which time his oldest son was also deployed to Iraq as a Corpsman with the First Marine Division.

Al is a graduate of Cuesta College and Cal-Poly, holding multiple earned degrees, to include a Master's Degree in International Relations from the University of Southern California. He is the President-elect of the San Luis Obispo County Lincoln Club, an alternate member of the SLO County Republican Central Committee and is a regular conservative columnist for the Atascadero News. He has been married to former Mayor and current City Councilwoman of Atascadero, Roberta Fonzi, for 38 years. They have four children and live in one of the oldest Colony Homes in Atascadero.

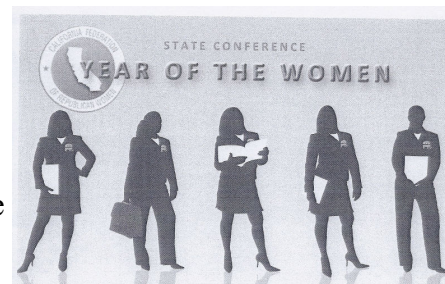

## FAMOUS DATES IN HISTORY

- January 1,  
1863      **EMANCIPATION PROCLAMATION:** Decree issued by President Lincoln during the Civil War abolished slavery in the rebel states. Led to the 13<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the Constitution in 1865 that abolished all slavery in the U.S.
- January 16,  
1991-  
April 6, 1991      **THE PERSIAN GULF WAR:** a multi-national coalition, led by the U.S., launched air strikes against Iraq after Iraq's refusal to leave Kuwait which it had overrun in August 1990. A 6 week ground assault, known as Desert Storm, ended the war.
- January 24,  
1848      **CALIFORNIA GOLD RUSH BEGINS:** James Marshall discovered gold at Sutter's Mill in the new U.S. territory of California. In 1849, 80,000 people emigrated to California to seek their fortunes.
- January 27,  
1973      **VIETNAM WAR ENDS:** The first advisors were sent to S. Vietnam in 1950 and 15,000 troops were sent by 1963. By 1968, 550,000 troops were present. The Peace Treaty was signed on January 27, 1973 and Saigon fell in May 1975.
- January 28,  
1986'      **SHUTTLE CHALLENGER EXPLODES:** The Challenger exploded 74 seconds after liftoff from Cape Canaveral, Florida, killing its crew of 7, including a civilian school teacher Christa McAuliffe. The space program was halted until Sept. 1988.
