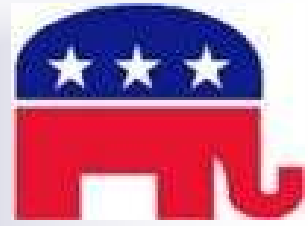

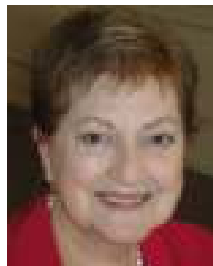

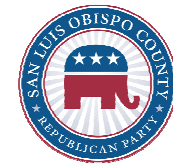

Whereas the California Republican Party platform supports *legal* immigration and our country's **right to control its borders**:

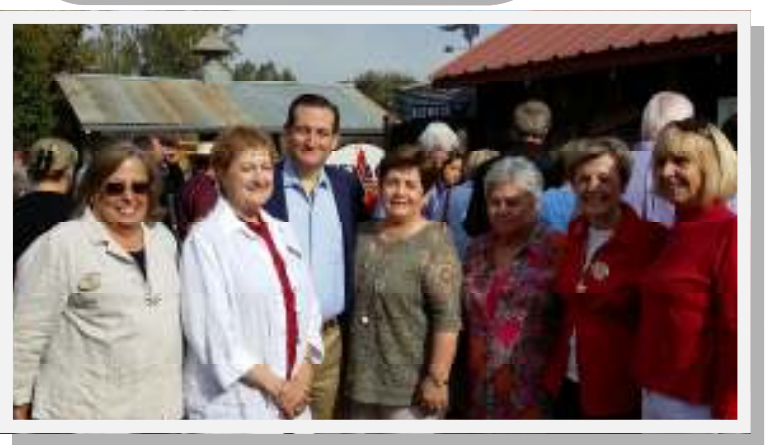
“We affirm our country's absolute right to control its borders. We support legal immigration and the immigration laws which are already in place, and call on the government to enforce all laws on the issue.”

Ivan Hudson and Mary Reents are going on the Honor Flight, September 28-30. Ivan is Mary's stepdad and is a WWII Navy Veteran; he is 91. He enlisted in the Navy at 19 and was a Pharmacist Mate on a transport ship in the Pacific for two years and never made land, and although he never landed, he did transport infantry onto the beaches of Guadalcanal and then fed ammunition into one of the ship's big guns, which shot down Japanese airplanes. His ship was supposed to be involved in the first landing in Japan, but that invasion was called off after Hiroshima. He was in the typhoon at the end of the war and his ship was damaged. It took them two months to return to San Diego. Ivan is an Associate member in our club and Mary wants to collect fun jokes, cards, etc. from well wishers, so that he will have mail during the mail call on the return plane trip from Washington D.C. He told Mary that during his time in the military, he never received any mail.



Ivan's flight leaves at 5 am from SLO Airport on September 28. That is early in the morning, but we know how much it means to the WWII and Korean Veterans to have a crowd to wish them a good flight. He'll return about 10 pm on September 30th.

The Veterans go on the Honor Flight for free and their Guardians pay their own way. Ivan, as well as the other 22 Vets would not be able to go on this trip if it weren't for the generosity of this and other republican women chapters and other donors that are raising funds for the Honor Flight. This year our club has raised \$1,228 thus far and our goal is \$1,500, the cost to send one Veteran on the Honor Flight. Last year we raised \$1,500. We are \$272 short of our goal and we hope to raise that amount before the September Honor Flight. Thank you for your generosity in helping the Honor Flight be such a success.

Don't forget we are continuing to pass the hat for the Honor Flight. We have sent one veteran and hope to send a second soon. A worthwhile project for all our members to participate in.
