This month, our members Sandi Tannler and Lorie Noble will present a program about the Election Integrity Project – CA. The EIP-Ca is a group of non-partisan citizen volunteers whose goal is to enable citizens to become active participants in the entire election process, from overseeing the integrity of the voter rolls, to ensuring that each lawfully cast vote is counted and counted fairly, and that all processes are in compliance with federal, state, and local laws, statutes and regulations. Training of these volunteers is done in person, online, and in this case, in a video by Linda Paine, who is the President and Co-founder of the EIR-Ca.

Our presenters are very active and well-known not only in our club, but in the CFRW Central Division and SLO County Republican Party.

Lorie is completing her second term as CFRW treasurer. Over the 27 years as a member of the Federation, she has served as CFRW Membership Secretary, Central Division Region III Director, Club President, and numerous other Club elected and appointed Offices. She is a current voting member of the SLO County Republican Party Central Committee. Lorie Lives in Morro Bay, and is a retired U.S. Army Chief Warrant Officer, serving over 42 years in the Army and California National Guard.

Sandi is the Past President for EBRWF 2014-2015, Past President for EBRWF 2018, RPSLO Member since 2010, RPSLO District Two Chairman since 2016, four-year term. 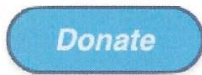
