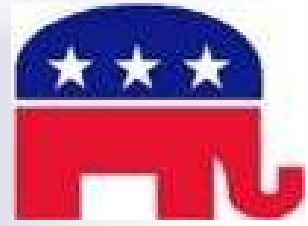

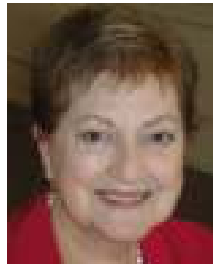

She has been actively involved in politics since 1965, serving in a variety of campaign efforts for many candidates, including that of her husband Eric Seastrand, who served in the State Assembly from 1982 to 1990. Andrea was a member of the State Assembly from 1990 to 1994 and a member of the U.S. House of Representatives in the 104th Congress from 1995 to 1997.

Mrs. Seastrand's length of accomplishments and experience is impressive—including her position as Executive Director of the statewide California Space Authority. She is currently a member of the Santa Lucia Republican Women Federated and an associate of the other four Republican Women Federateds, as well as a member of the California Republican Assembly. Most recently, Mrs. Seastrand's efforts contributed substantially to Lynn Compton's successful campaign to secure a seat on the Board of Supervisors seat representing the 4th District in South County.

Andrea has two grown children and four grandchildren, and currently resides in City of Grover Beach.

Senate Bill 16 would raise gas taxes 10 - 12 cents and increase car tax \$35

Greetings!

After passing the Senate Transportation and Housing committee with a 6-1 vote, SB 16 is now scheduled to be heard in the Senate Appropriations Committee on Tuesday.

SB 16, a proposal by Jim Beall (D - San Jose) raises gas prices on California motorists, even though we already pay the nation's highest gas prices by far according to [GasBuddy](#). While Beall claims the state needs more money for roads, SB 16 does nothing to address the [diversion](#) of billions in gas tax revenue to purposes other than transportation.

GET THE FACTS

SB 16 is a bad idea for many reasons. With billions in surplus revenue and a 10 - 15 cent hidden gas tax that was just imposed by state bureaucrats in January, now would not seem like a good time for another gas tax increase. The fact sheet is a resource that explains why SB 16 should be rejected and how citizens can get involved to help.
