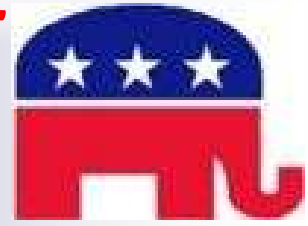

Here's your chance to do something, a time to step up.

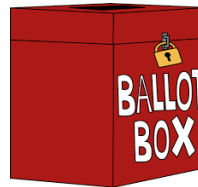
Help Needed
